

For a Rainy Day

On a rainy day, you will see many people with umbrellas. Sometimes, people use them when it is sunny, too. But where did umbrellas come from?

Umbrellas were used thousands of years ago in countries such as Egypt and China. At first, people only used umbrellas to stay cool on hot days. Later, umbrellas for the rain were made by the Chinese.

In Europe, people started using umbrellas in the 17th century. Only women used umbrellas then. They thought umbrellas looked pretty. So, when a man called Jonas Hanway carried an umbrella around London, people laughed at him. kept using his umbrella for 30 years, and other men began using umbrellas, too. They often called their umbrellas "Hanways" because of Jonas Hanway.

In 1830, the first shop that only sold umbrellas opened in London. It is still there today, at 53 New Oxford Street. At that time, umbrellas were usually made of wood and were very heavy. Then, in 1852, a man called Samuel Fox invented* umbrellas made of steel.* But only rich people could buy them.

In the 1920s in Germany, someone invented a very small umbrella that could be put in your pocket. This one was like the umbrellas some people use today. In the 1960s, nylon* umbrellas became popular because they were light and cheap. Then, the number of people who use umbrellas grew around the world. Today, about 33 million umbrellas are sold every year in the United States, and most of them are made in China.
