#### **Dinner Tickets**

In 2012, a new restaurant called Next opened in Chicago. Grant Achatz, one of America's most famous chefs, started the restaurant, and it soon became one of the most popular restaurants in the city. But Next is not a (36) restaurant. What makes it different from other restaurants is that people who want to eat there must buy a ticket before they go. Also, the same meal is served to everyone in the restaurant.

Achatz says that he decided to sell tickets for Next because he wants the dinners there to be special events. Every three months, Next creates a new meal with a different theme. For example, one time it offered dishes that people in Paris used to eat more than a hundred years ago. Everyone eats the same dinner, but it is a special one that is only served for a limited time. Although they cannot (37) what they eat, people enjoy going to Next because it is such a unique dining experience.

Once you buy a ticket for Next, you cannot get your money back, but you can sell your ticket to someone else. Thanks to this system, the restaurant knows exactly how many meals to prepare each day. Even if customers suddenly decide not to go, the restaurant does not lose money. This is because the customers bave already (38). As a result, the restaurant can offer high-quality food at lower prices than other high-class restaurants. If Next's system continues to be successful, more restaurants may try selling tickets in the future.

## A New Kind of Park

In many large cities, building parks and green spaces for the people who live there is very difficult. This is especially true in crowded places like New York City, where land for parks not only costs a lot but is also hard to find. For this reason, New York City has been finding creative ways to build new parks. One park, for example, has been built high above the streets on an old railroad line that is no longer being used. Now, people are even talking about an idea for a new park under the ground.

A group in New York City is planning to build a park in an old underground trolley depot.\* The city used the depot between 1903 and 1948, but it has been empty since then. It is known as the Delancey Underground, and the group believes that the new park would help to create a relaxing public space in the crowded part of New York City called Manhattan.

The park's designers, Dan Barasch and James Ramsey, have found a way to allow trees and plants to grow underground. Their idea is to use natural light. They are planning to use a new technology that can send natural light through cables. The designers say that this will give trees and plants enough light to grow in the park.

Because the park would be located underground, it would be possible to hold events there throughout the year. The designers hope that, in addition to usual park activities like picnics and walking dogs, people could enjoy art exhibitions and other events in all kinds of weather. It may take a few years for the Delancey Underground park to be built, but if Barasch and Ramsey are successful, New York City will be home to the world's first park below the ground.


