The Phonograph

Until about 200 years ago, there was no recorded sound. When people wanted to hear music, they could not just listen to CDs. Instead, they needed someone to (36) it for them. However, in the 1800s, some people began trying to make machines that could record sounds. Then, in 1877, Thomas Edison invented a machine called the phonograph that could do this.

The phonograph recorded sounds onto a kind of tube called a cylinder, which was made from a very thin sheet of metal. The machine recorded the sound by cutting small lines into the cylinder, but the thin metal was not very strong. Because of this, each recording could only be listened to (37). To solve this problem, Edison began making cylinders out of wax.* These were stronger, so people could listen to a recording many times before the cylinders broke.

However, because of the cylinders' shape, it was difficult to make copies of recordings. A different inventor, Emile Berliner, (38) this situation. In 1887, Berliner invented a new machine called the gramophone, which used flat discs instead of cylinders. Because the discs were flat, it was much easier to make copies of them. Also, these discs could hold longer recordings. Soon, people began recording music onto the discs, and they could listen to it whenever they wanted.

Plane Trees

The French countryside is known for the beautiful long lines of trees that grow along the sides of roads and rivers. Most of these trees are a kind called plane trees. These trees have been a part of the French countryside for centuries. They were first planted for wood and to give shade along the roads. Now, however, these trees are in danger.

One danger for the trees is a disease that was accidentally brought to France from America by soldiers during World War II. Since then, thousands of plane trees along the Canal du Midi, a manmade river built in the 17th century, have caught this disease. These trees are being cut down to keep the disease from spreading, but this is bad for the river because the roots of the trees are needed to protect the walls of the river. New trees are heing planted, but they will take many years to grow.

Another danger, however, comes from people who want to cut them down for other reasons. One reason they want to do this is that a large number of people die in accidents in which cars hit the plane trees. As a result, some trees have been cut down to try to make roads safer. For example, a group of motorcycle riders cut down about 100 of the trees after a rider died in an accident. Even the French Minister of Agriculture has said that all the trees should be cut down.

However, some people disagree. They say that the trees are not the problem. These people believe that such accidents are caused by people driving too fast. Chantal Fauché, a French woman who is trying to save the trees, says that even if the trees are removed, bad drivers will continue to have accidents. Still, the number of these trees has gone down from around 3 million to 250,000 over the last 100 years.
