Hospital Clowns

Clowns are people who dress in funny clothes and often paint their faces white and put on red noses. They tell jokes or do funny things to make people laugh. This is why many hospitals use clowns to (33) young patients. Clowns are often hired to perform for sick children, and clown faces are often painted on the walls of children's hospital rooms.

In a recent British survey, 250 hospital patients aged between 4 and 16 were interviewed about their experiences in hospitals. The Corps of Discovery

Today, the United States is one of the largest nations in the world. When it first began, however, it covered only a small area of North America in the east near the Atlantic Ocean. In 1803, the president, Thomas Jefferson, chose a group of men to send to the West to explore. This group was called the Corps of Discovery. Their mission was to learn about the geography, the climate, the animals, and the people living there. Jefferson also hoped that they would find rivers that went across the country to help make traveling easier.

Meriwether Lewis and William Clark were the leaders of the group. Along with 40 other men, they began their journey on May 14, 1804. Traveling west by boat, by horse, and on foot, they took careful notes of everything that they saw. However, they had trouble communicating with the Native American people that they met. In one village, though, they met a Native American woman named Sacagawea who could translate for them.

Sacagawea spoke a few languages and knew the area well, so Lewis and Clark asked her to join the group. In addition to translating for them, Sacagawea helped them in many ways. She showed them the easiest places to travel, taught them safe places to stay, and most importantly, helped them communicate peacefully with the native people. Thanks to her, the group safely reached the Pacific Ocean.

Although the group was unable to find rivers that connected the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans, their trip was successful. They drew the first maps of the area and discovered many plants and animals that lived in the West. This information was useful for the United States and helped people start new lives in the West. The Corps of Discovery and Sacagawea are an important part of early American history.
