Life on Land

Nowadays, there are many types of animals and plants living in the oceans and on land. Billions of years ago, though, living things could only live in the oceans. The air was filled with harmful gases, and it was impossible for animals to breathe. About 500 million years ago, plants began to grow on land. They helped to (28). Slowly, they took the harmful gases from the air and replaced them with oxygen. After a while, they created an environment where animals could live.

Insects, such as ants and beetles, were one of the first types of living things to live on land. An international team of scientists worked together to look at over a thousand types of insects. Using new technology, they were able to learn new facts about the history of life on Earth. (29), they found out that the first insects began to live on Earth about 480 million years ago. This is much earlier than scientists had first believed.

The team also learned about how insects began to fly. Their research showed that about 400 million years ago, plants began to change. They started to (30). Then, insects began to climb up to the top of these plants to eat. Sometimes the insects would fall from these high places. Over time, their bodies changed and this made it easier for them to jump and fall. By 350 million years ago, some insects had even developed wings so they could fly.

A Popular Ride

In the late 19th century, events called world's fairs were held in many different cities. People from all around the world gathered at these fairs to introduce inventions or technologies that had just been developed. Many things were first introduced at world's fairs. For instance, the telephone was introduced at the 1876 World's Fair in Philadelphia, in the United States. Also, the Eiffel Tower, which was built for the 1889 World's Fair in Paris, became famous all over the world.

After Paris, the next world's fair was held in Chicago in 1893. The planners wanted to build something that was as great as the Eiffel Tower. A man named George Ferris designed a giant wheel that carried people high above the ground so that they could see all around them. He called it a Ferris wheel.* This first Ferris wheel was 80 meters tall, had 36 cars, and over 2,100 people could ride it at one time. During the world's fair, it was ridden by over 1.5 million people.

However, the ride caused a number of problems for Ferris. First, the giant wheel was very expensive to build. Even though many people rode it, Ferris made very little money. Then, after the fair was over, Ferris had to take apart the huge wheel and remove it. Because of its size, this was a very expensive project. As a result, when Ferris died in 1896, he was very poor.

Even though Ferris's life did not end well, people continued to use his design to build modern Ferris wheels. However, they have learned from his mistakes. Some people design smaller Ferris wheels that are easy to move from one park to another for local festivals. Other Ferris wheels, like the 135-meter-tall London Eye, are kept in one place. Whatever size they are, Ferris wheels are enjoyed by people around the world.
