Lake Eyre

In the desert of central Australia, there is a special lake called Lake Eyre. When large amounts of rain fall in northern Australia, the water flows through the rivers and fills the lake. However, this only happens once every eight years. After the rain stops, the lake gets smaller and smaller. After a while, the lake becomes (**28**). With no water, all that is left is a huge area of salt.

When there is no water, few people visit, and there are hardly any animals around. However, once the rain falls again, the scenery changes. (**29**) come to the area. For example, fish travel along the rivers and begin to live in the lake. Birds fly from all over Australia to lay their eggs. Scientists found more than 500,000 birds in the area in 1990. In addition, shrimp and insects come to life when the water returns.

However, some people are worried that this special lake may disappear forever. Companies now use water from the rivers around the lake. They use it for farming and other businesses. If they use too much, there may not be any water left to make Lake Eyre. Now, groups are trying to (**30**). A Children's Toy

Many people dream of becoming rich by selling a new product. However, it is often difficult to start and run a new business. Even with good ideas and hard work, many products and businesses fail. One company that failed many times before it became a success was Kutol — the maker of a popular children's toy called Play-Doh.*

It started in 1933, when Kutol began having trouble selling its soap. Cleo McVicker, Kutol's president, needed to find a new way to make money. He heard that the heaters that people used in their homes made their walls dirty. Therefore, many people needed wallpaper cleaner to wipe their walls clean. Cleo's brother, Noah McVicker, found a way to make wallpaper cleaner. The company started selling the wallpaper cleaner to grocery stores. With its new product, Kutol began making money again.

However, in the 1950s, people began using new types of heaters that did not make the walls dirty. As a result, people stopped buying wallpaper cleaner, and Kutol was in trouble again. Luckily, the new president, Joe McVicker, heard that the wallpaper cleaner had a different use. Some teachers used it in their art classes because it was easy and fun for children to play with. Kutol added some colors to its wallpaper cleaner and started to sell it as a children's toy, Play-Doh.

At first, Kutol sold Play-Doh to schools and department stores in the United States. Then, in 1957, a character on a popular children's TV show began to play with Play-Doh. As a result, it became very popular in the United States and Europe. In 1965, Kutol sold Play-Doh to a large American toy company, and today, over 95 million cans of Play-Doh are sold every year. The story of Play-Doh shows that people should not give up when they have a problem. Instead, they must keep trying.
