Future perfect

I will have eaten

We use the future perfect when we are thinking about time before and up to a specific point in the future.

Ex.

"Please don't phone me at midnight; I will have gone to bed".

This communicates that you will go to bed before midnight and that, at midnight, you will be in bed, probably sleeping.

When do we use the future perfect?

We use the future perfect when we are thinking about time before and up to a specific point in the future

Give me an example, please

When you arrive at my house, I will have cooked dinner.

٠

What does that sentence mean?

That sentence means that I will finish cooking dinner before you arrive at my house; when you arrive, dinner will be ready

Tell me the difference between these two sentences:

"At 9 o'clock, I will eat my dinner". and

"At 9 o'clock, I will have eaten my dinner"

The difference ... Is that "At 9 o'clock, I will eat my dinner" means I will start to eat my dinner at 9 o'clock, whereas "At 9 o'clock, I will have eaten my dinner" means that my dinner will already be finished at 9 o'clock
