What are the verb forms of 'eat'?

The verb forms of 'eat' are 'eat, ate, eaten'.

Have you ever eaten in a French restaurant?

Yes, I have eaten in a French restaurant.

No, I haven't eaten in a French restaurant.

What are the verb forms of 'give'?

The verb forms of 'give' are 'give, gave, given'.

Have you ever given money to poor people?

Yes, I've sometimes given money to poor people.

No, I've never given money to poor people.

What are the verb forms of 'know'?

The verb forms of 'know' are 'know, knew, known'.

How long have you known me?

I've known you for 2 years.

How long have you known me?

I've known you for 8 months.

Since when?

Since July.

What are the verb forms of 'see'?

The verb forms of 'see' are 'see, saw, seen'.

Have you ever seen me outside the school?

Yes, I've seen you outside the school.

no, I've never seen you outside the school.

What are the verb forms of 'wear'?

The verb forms of 'wear' are 'wear, wore, worn'.

Did you wear trousers yesterday?

Yes, I wore trousers yesterday

No, I didn't wear trousers yesterday, I wore jeans yesterday.

The verb forms of 'drink' are 'drink, drank, drunk'.

Have you ever drunk green tea?

Yes, I have drunk green tea.

No, I haven't drunk green tea

What are the verb forms of 'learn'?

The verb forms of 'learn' are 'learn, learnt, learnt'.

How many new words have you learnt this week?

I Have learnt about fifty new words this week.

What are the verb forms of 'teach'?

The verb forms of 'teach' are 'teach, taught, taught'.

How many new words have I taught today?

You have taught about twenty new words today.

What are the verb forms of 'tell'?

The verb forms of 'tell' are 'tell, told, told'.

Have I told you my name?

Yes, you have told us your name.

What are the verb forms of 'think'?

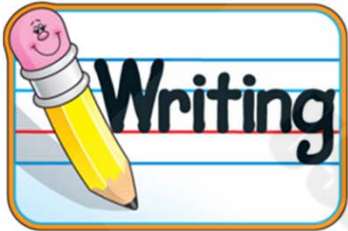
The verb forms of 'think' are 'think, thought, thought'.

Yes, I have thought of going on a trip.

No, I haven't thought of going on a trip.
