### Vocabularies

**PROGRAM:** A listing of the order of events and other pertinent information for a public presentation.

**Example:** "the program lasted more than two hours"

**QUIET:** Making little or no noise

**Example:** "a quiet audience at the concert"

**MISTAKES:** A misconception or misunderstanding.

**Example:** "he wasn't going to admit his mistake"

**LISTEN:** To make an effort to hear something, to pay attention

**Example:** "Listen to your father"
