### Vocabularies

**Party –** a social event at which people meet to celebrate to have fun by eating and drinking, dancing, etc something or playing games

**Example:** Are you going to Sally's birthday party?

**Snack –** a small amount of food that you eat between meals

**Example:** I offered some blueberry muffin and soda for snacks



**Prepare –** Means to make food ready to be cooked or eaten, for example by cleaning or cutting it

**Example :** Wash your hands before eating or preparing food.

**Means -** to make plans for a future event so that you will be ready for it

**Example :** We're preparing a special reception for him when he returns.

**Guest-** someone who you have invited to your home, for a party or , to stay the night for a meal

**Example :** We've got guests staying this weekend.
