Vocabularies

socks - Hosiery consisting of a cloth covering for the foot; worn inside the shoe; reaches to between the ankle and the knee

Example: *"A pair of socks"*

trousers - (usually in the plural) a garment extending from the waist to the knee or ankle, covering each leg separately

Example: *"He had a sharp crease in his trousers."*

underwear - Undergarment worn next to the skin and under the outer garments

suit - A set of garments (usually including a jacket and trousers or skirt) for outerwear all of the same fabric and colour

Example: *"Mr. brown's suit"*

undershirt - A collarless men's undergarment for the upper part of the body

Example: *"Where's my undershirt?"*
