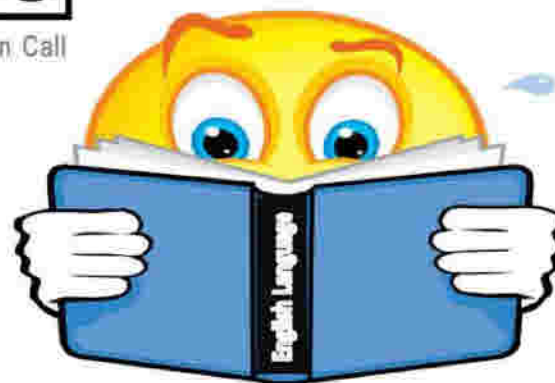

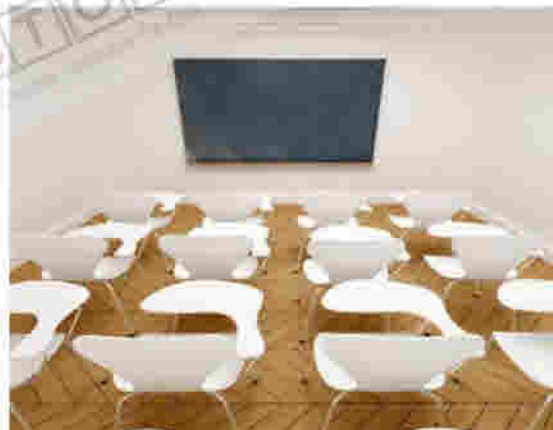

CORE ED STAGE 2

When using question words like “what, which and where”, we put the **preposition** last in the sentence.

Ex. Where do you come from?

1. What do we speak with?

We speak with our mouths.



2. Where am I taking the book from?

You're taking the book from the table.

You're putting the pen
under the book.



4. What are you sitting on?

I'm sitting on a chair.
