Vocabularies

test - A set of questions or exercises evaluating skill or knowledge

"When the test was stolen the professor had to make a new set of questions"

camp - A site where care and activities are provided for children during the summer months

"City kids get to see the country at a summer camp."

weather - The atmospheric conditions that comprise the state of the atmosphere in terms of temperature and wind and clouds and precipitation

"They were hoping for good weather."

trip - A journey for some purpose (usually including the return)

"He took a trip to the shopping centre."

party - A group of people gathered together for pleasure

"She joined the party after dinner."



picnic - A day devoted to an outdoor social gathering
"We picnicked near the lake on this gorgeous Sunday"

terrible - Exceptionally bad or displeasing
"terrible handwriting"
