Are you tall enough to touch the ceiling?

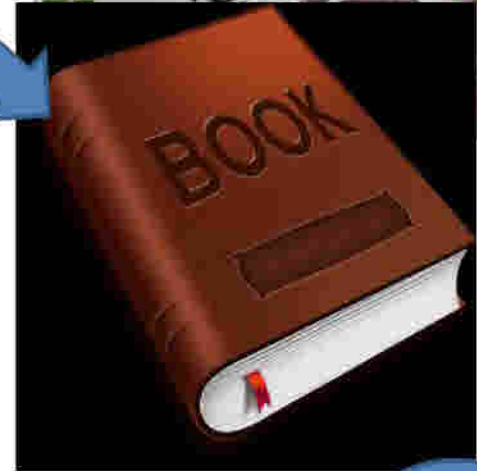
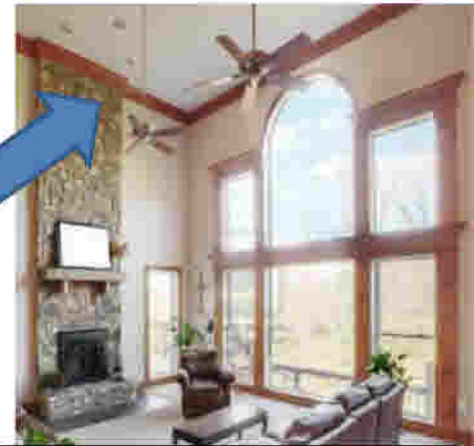

That one's white.



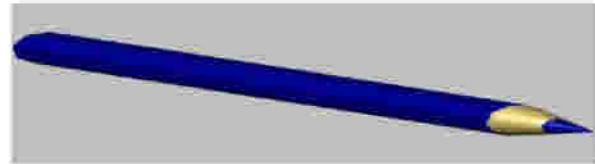

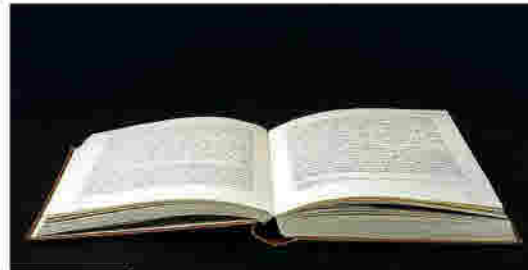
