/s/ and /ʃ/

Sound 1:

/s/ is the sound in **so**, **fasten**, and **glass**.

To make the /s/ sound:

- Push your tongue up against the top and sides of your mouth.
- Blow some air out between the tip of your tongue and your teeth.

Sound 2:

/ʃ/ is the sound in **ship**, **rush**, and **fashion**.

To make the /ʃ/ sound:

- Bend back the front part of your tongue.
- Then, touch the space behind your teeth with the front of your tongue
- Blow some air out through the space.
