Word Booster/ Health Idioms



<p><u>black out</u></p> <p>as <u>blind</u> as a bat</p>	<p>If you black out, you lose consciousness.</p> <p>Someone whose vision is very poor, or who is unable to see anything, is (as) blind as a bat.</p> <p>"Without his glasses the old man is as blind as a bat."</p>
<p>feel <u>blue</u></p>	<p>To feel blue means to have feelings of deep sadness or depression.</p>
<p>kick the <u>bucket</u></p>	<p>To kick the bucket is a light-hearted way of talking about death.</p> <p>"He will inherit when his grandfather kicks the bucket."</p>
<p><u>clean bill of health</u></p>	<p>If a person has a clean bill of health, they have a report or certificate declaring that their health is satisfactory.</p>
<p>be off <u>colour</u></p>	<p>If you are off colour, you are looking or feeling ill.</p>
<p><u>dead</u> as a doornail</p>	<p>This expression is used to stress that a person or thing is unquestionably dead.</p> <p>"As soon as the golf ball hit the rabbit, he was dead as a doornail."</p>
