Weather is the state of the atmosphere, to the degree that it is hot or cold, wet or dry, calm or stormy, clear or cloudy. Weather generally refers to day-to-day temperature and precipitation activity, whereas climate is the term for the average atmospheric conditions over

longer periods of time.

sunny- Bright with sunlight

cloudy- Covered with or characterized by clouds; overcast.

rainy- Having a great deal of rainfall.

windy- Marked by or exposed to strong winds.

muggy- Unpleasantly warm and humid.

humid- Marked by a relatively high level of

water vapor in the atmosphere.

dry- Free from moisture or liquid; not wet or moist.

frosty- Very cold with frost forming on surfaces.

hot- Having a high degree of heat or a high temperature.

cool- Of or at a fairly low temperature.

chilly- Uncomfortably cool or cold.

freezing- Below 32°F (0°C).
