<p><b>Castle</b> - a large strong building, built in the past by a ruler or important person to protect the people inside from attack.</p>	<p><i>The castle is so very big and beautiful.</i></p>
<p><b>Build</b> - to make a structure or something else by putting materials together in a particular way.</p>	<p><i>We decided to build on high ground, above the river.</i></p>
<p><b>Costume</b> - a set of clothes worn in order to look like someone else, esp. for a party or as part of an entertainment.</p>	<p><i>I dressed like a clown for the costume party.</i></p>
