

## Lesson 1: Expect Obedience



### Vocabulary Practice:

<p><b>Obedience</b> - doing or willing to do what you have been asked or ordered to do by someone in authority.</p>	<p><i>She demands absolute obedience from her children.</i></p>
<p><b>School</b> - a place where people, esp. young people, are educated.</p>	<p><i>The kids walk to school.</i></p>
<p><b>Thermometer</b> - a device used for measuring temperature, esp. of the air or in a person's body.</p>	<p><i>I need to use the thermometer to check if I have a fever.</i></p>

Dialogue Reading:

**Tina:** I think I am not feeling well, mom.

**Mom:** Hmm. Let me check your temperature.

**Tina:** Oh, it's ok, mom. As you can see I have a cold.

**Mom:** I need to check your temperature to see if you have a fever.

**Tina:** Ok. Let me use the toilet room first.

**Mom:** Ok, put this thermometer in your mouth and then show me later.

(After 5 minutes)

**Mom:** Tina, where is the thermometer?

**Tina:** Here mom.

**Mom:** It seems that you are feeling well. What seems to be the problem?

**Tina:** I am not feeling well, mom, believe me!

**Mom:** Well, you don't have a fever. I think you're fine! You don't want to go to school, do you?

**Tina:** To be honest, I don't want to go to school. I'm tired mom!

**Mom:** Tina, you know that attending school is very important. It talks about your future. Go on, get ready for school.

**Tina:** But mom...

**Mom:** No "buts", dear. You are lucky that you can go to school. Other children can't afford it. You are so lucky. Go ahead and get ready.
