<p>Model - someone or something that is an extremely good example of its type, esp. when a copy can be based on it.</p>	<p><i>She was a model of loyalty and got a reward for being one.</i></p>
<p>Discipline - training that produces obedience or self-control, often in the form of rules and punishments if these are broken, or the obedience or self-control produced by this training.</p>	<p><i>My son was quite disciplined after he joined the military.</i></p>
<p>Grocery - the food and other items that you buy in a food store or supermarket.</p>	<p><i>My wife wrote a check to pay for groceries.</i></p>
