<p>Catch - to discover, find, or become aware of something.</p>	<p><i>I hope I catch all the mistakes in my term paper.</i></p>
<p>Dishes - all the plates, glasses, knives, forks, etc., that have been used during a meal.</p>	<p><i>Who's going to do the dishes? ("do" in this sentence means "wash")</i></p>
<p>Wash - to make something or yourself clean, or to become clean, using water and usually soap.</p>	<p><i>I hate washing dishes.</i></p>
