THE USE OF (I'M) GOING TO (DO)

I. RULES AND EXAMPLES

1. To use **I am going to do** something means I have already decided to do it, I intend to do it:

Examples:

- 1. A: **Are** you **going to watch** the late film on TV tonight? B: No, **I'm going to have** an early night.
- 2. A: I hear Sarah has won some money. What **is** she **going to do** with it?
 - B: She's going to buy a new car.
- 3. **I'm** just **going to make** a quick phone call. Can you wait for me?
- 4. This cheese looks horrible. I'm not going to eat it.

2. To use I was going to (do something) means I intended to do it, but didn't do it.

Examples:

- 1. We were going to travel by train, but then we decided to go by car instead.
- 2. Peter was going to do the exam, but he changed his mind.
- 3. I was just going to cross the road when somebody shouted 'Stop!'
