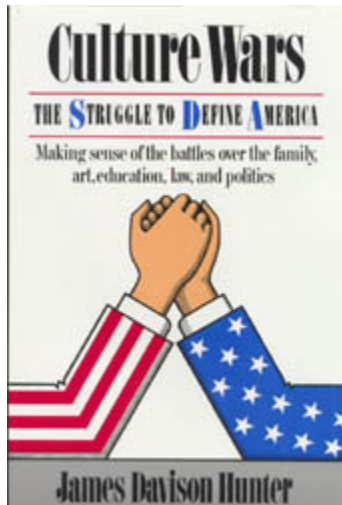

## AGREEMENT AND DISAGREEMENT

### **nail (something) down**

- to make certain or sure
