

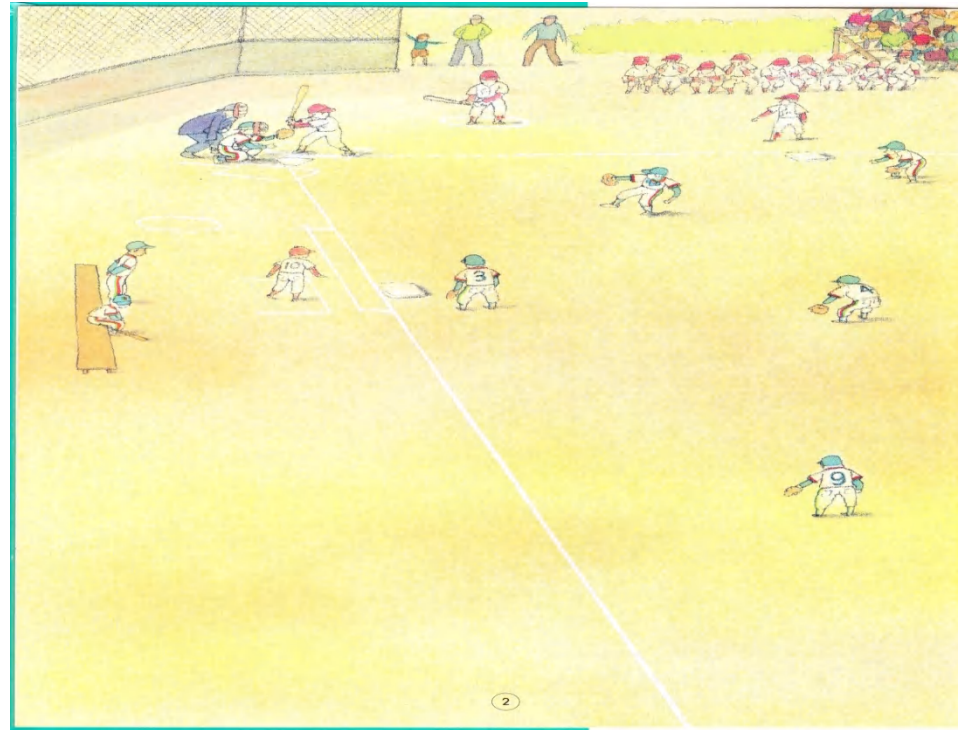

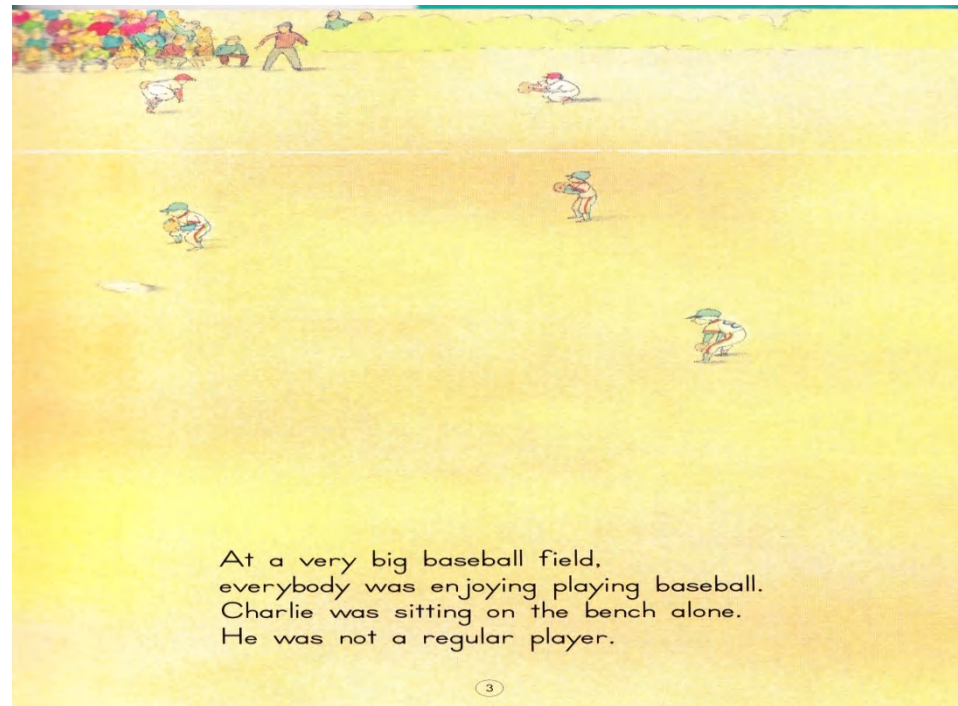

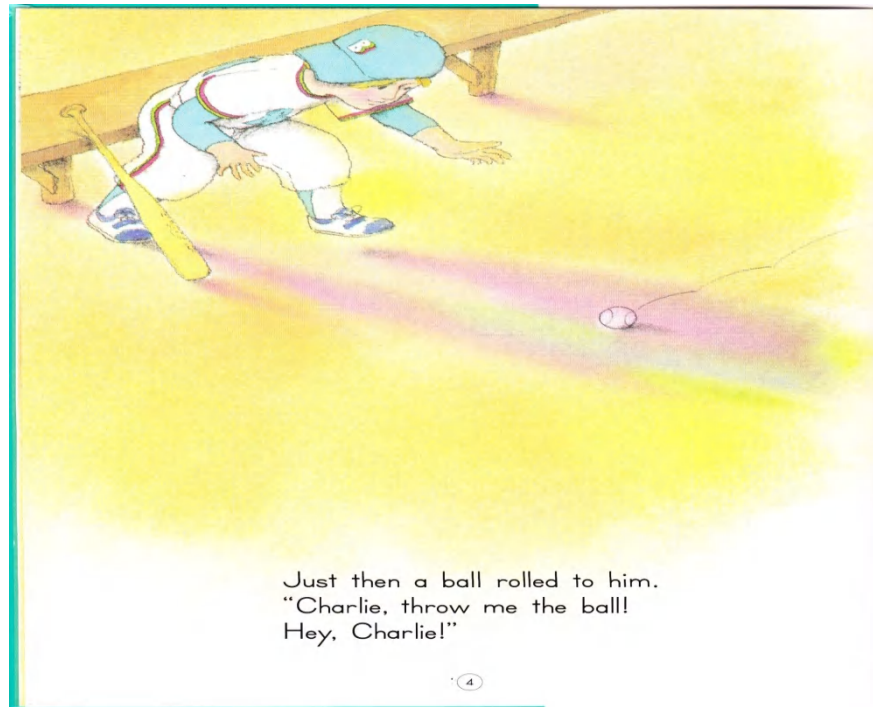

He was not a regular player.

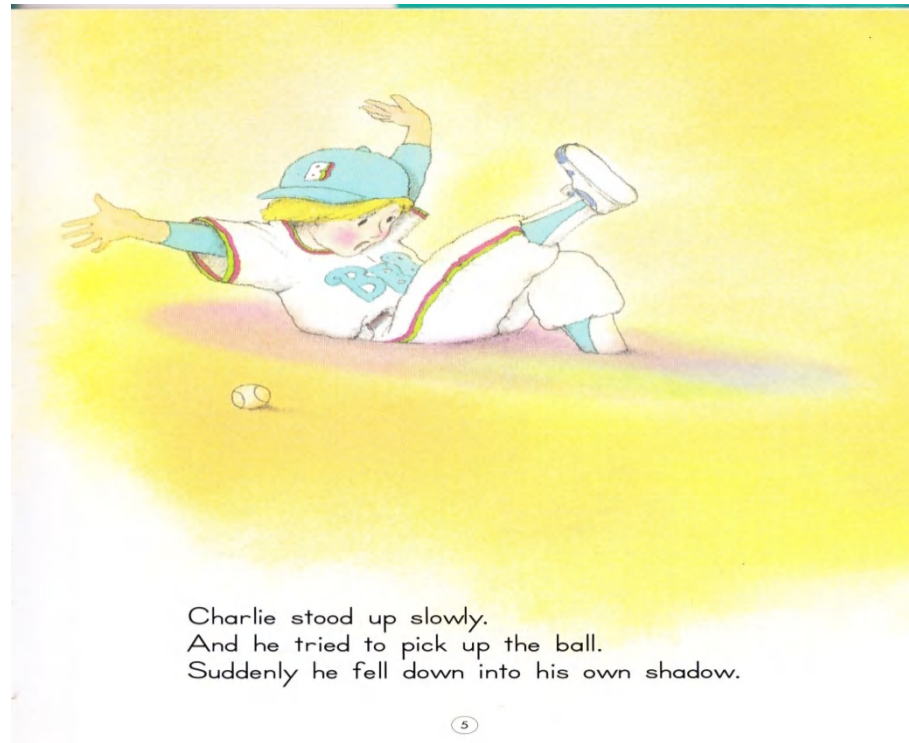
