

### CALLAN INFO:

The Callan Method is a fast and effective system for the study of English by non-native speakers. It is securely established and internationally respected.

### CALLAN METHOD:

- The teacher must ask the student to repeat the word/s in BOLD letters.  
E.g. Repeat after me "PEN"  
"PENCIL"  
"BOOK"
- 1. The teacher must make sure that the student pronounces the word/s correctly, otherwise, repetition is a must.
- 2. Vocabulary introduction must be done with the visual, thus, the teacher is required to show the student the pictures provided by the management.
- The teacher asks students a series of questions which the students must answer.
  1. Repetition is a must, to get student's attention and concentrate on the it to formulate the answer.

e.g. What's this? What's this?

- The teacher must make sure that the student answers in COMPLETE sentence/s and use the contraction, otherwise, repetition is a must.

e.g.

teacher: What's this? What's this?

Student: pen

Teacher: repeat after me "It's a pen."

Student: It's a pen.

Teacher: good. Again "What's this? What's this?"

- Sometimes The teacher has to read a paragraph before asking the question. The teacher must do this slowly in order for the student to catch up and understand. Reading must be done TWICE. After reading, the teacher must ask the student to repeat after her/him, then the question will follow which requires student to answer in complete sentence/s.

e.g

Please listen: " The difference between a house / and a flat/ is that/, a house is a part of a building/ generally where one family lives/ whilst a flat/ is a part of a building. AGAIN  
" " The difference between a house / and a flat/ is that/, a house is a part of a building/  
generally where one family lives/ whilst a flat/ is a part of a building.

Please repeat after me: " The difference between a house / and a flat/ is that/, A HOUSE IS A BUILDING/ generally where one family lives/ whilst a flat/ is a part of a building."

Student: (do so)

Teacher: very good, now answer the questions, "What's the difference between a house and a flat? What's the difference between a house and a flat?"

(When asking, the teacher must read the question in her/his natural pace. She/he should not slow down. This is a practice for student to enhance their listening skills at the same time.)

(The teacher must keep asking until the student gets the complete answer.)

(Student must answer RIGHT AFTER the question. There must be NO DELAY. This is to avoid giving student the time to translate the question in his/her mind in Japanese to gain full comprehension first before answering the question.)

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
