You're drawing a (spider) now

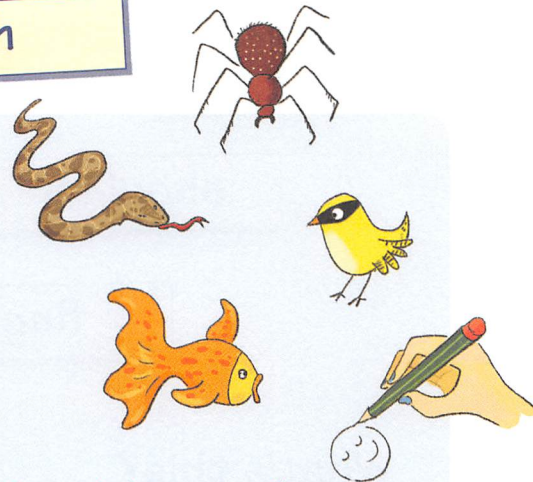
Am I drawing with a pen?

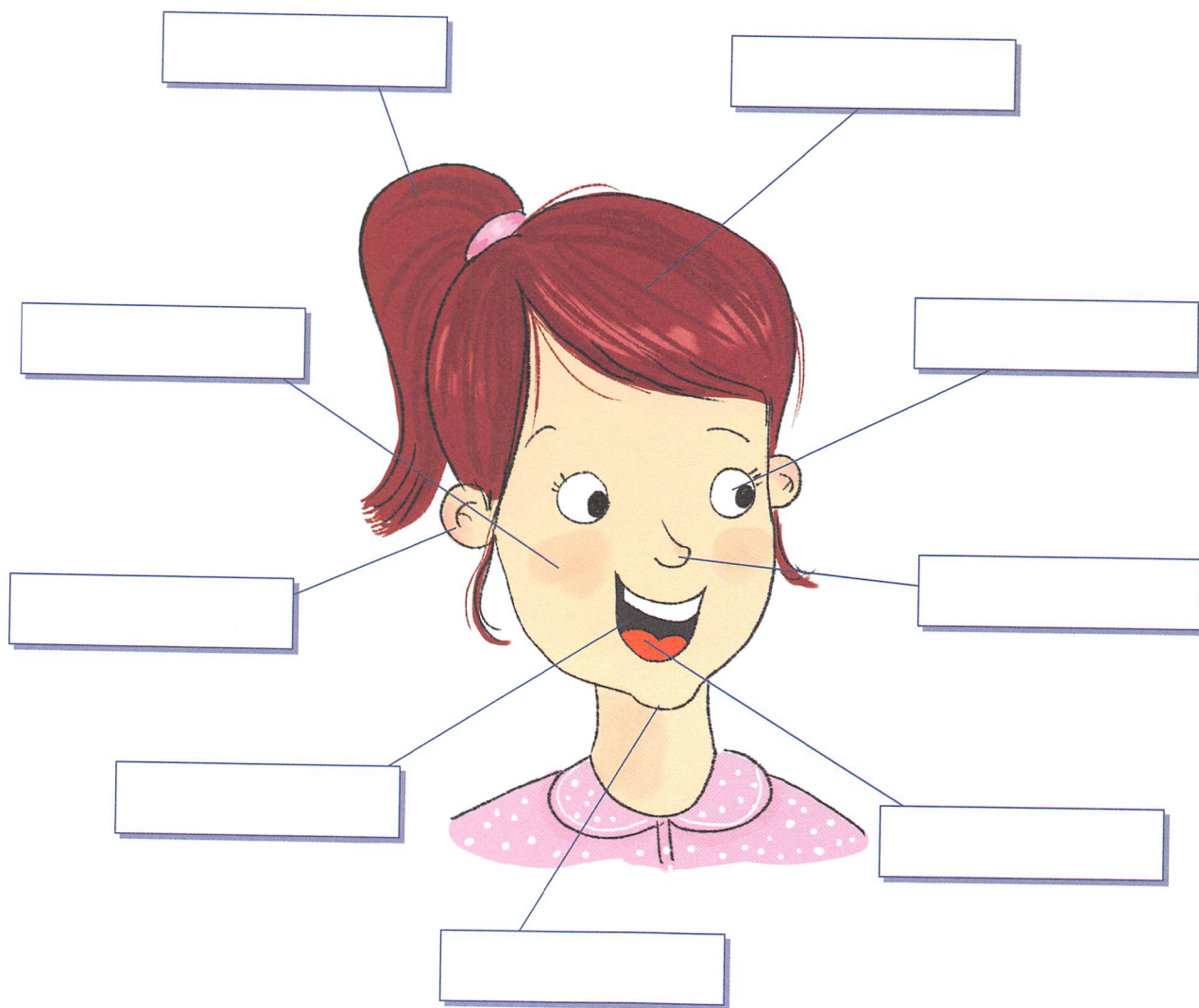
