What's a verb?

A verb is a word we use for an action

Is the word "read" a verb?

Yes, the word "read" is a verb

What's a noun?

A noun is the name of a thing, person or animal

Is the word "picture" a noun?

Yes, the word "picture" is a noun

Is the word "come" a noun?

No, the word "come" isn't a noun; it's a verb

Which book's closed?

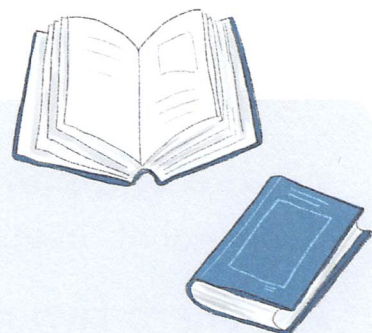
That book's closed

Is the door open?

Yes, the door's open ~ No, the door isn't open; it's closed

Is the window closed?

Yes, the window's closed ~ No, the window isn't closed; it's open



# have (positive)

I have

I've

you have

you've

he has

he's

she has

she's

it has

it's

we have

we've

you have

you've

they have

they've

With "he", "she" and "it",  
we say "has".



What's the meaning of the verb "have"?

*The meaning of the verb "have" is ...*

Give me a sentence with "I have", please.

*I have a blue book; I have two ears etc.*

Give me a sentence with "he has", please.

*He has short hair; he has one nose etc.*

What's the contraction of "I have, you have" etc.?

*I've, you've etc.*

generally

got

After the verb "have", we generally use the word "got" – we say "I've got", "you've got", "he's got" etc.



Have I got two eyes?

Yes, you've got two eyes

Have you got two ears?

Yes, I've got two ears

Has he got one nose?

Yes, he's got one nose

Has she got two hands?

Yes, she's got two hands

Have we got two heads?

Yes, we've got two heads

Have they got four arms?

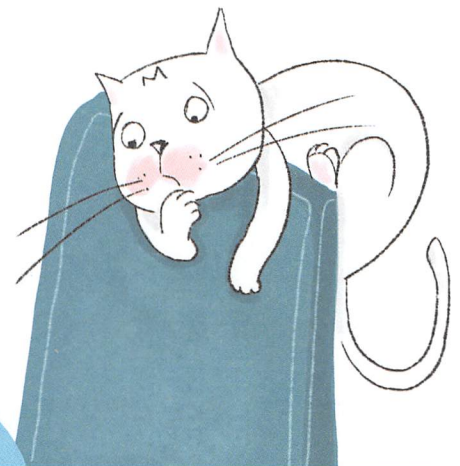
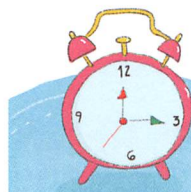
Yes, they've got four arms
