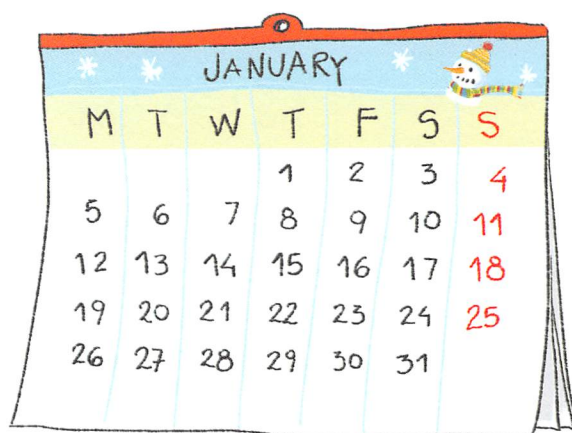

we haven't

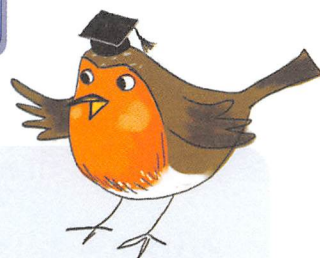
you have not

What's the negative of "I have got"?

The negative of "I have got" is "I have not got"

What's the contraction of "I have not got"?

The contraction of "I have not got" is "I haven't got"

Have you got two heads?

No, I haven't got two heads; I've only got one head

Has she only got one hand?

No, she hasn't only got one hand; she's got two hands

Has this chair only got two legs?

No, that chair hasn't only got two legs; it's got four legs

Have we only got one mouth?

No, we haven't only got one mouth; we've got two mouths

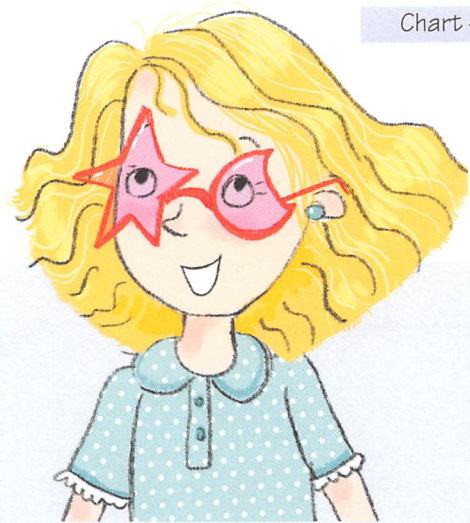
Have they got three noses?
