Where's the table?

The table's in front of me

Is the wall behind you?

Yes, the wall's behind me

Is the chair in front of me?

Yes, the chair's in front of you

Is the wall in front of you?

No, the wall isn't in front of me; it's behind me

Is the table behind me?

No, the table isn't behind you; it's in front of you

Is the cat behind the mouse?

Yes, the cat's behind the mouse

Is the dog in front of the cat?

No, the dog isn't in front of the cat; it's behind the cat

Is the mouse behind the dog?

No, the mouse isn't behind the dog; it's in front of the dog

Is the dog behind the mouse or in front of the mouse?

The dog's behind the mouse

The house is behind him

Where's the house?

The house is behind her

Are you behind her?

No, I'm not behind her; I'm in front of her

Am I in front of him?

No, you aren't in front of him; you're behind him

Are you sitting on the chair?

Yes, I'm sitting on the chair

Am I standing on the floor?

Yes, you're standing on the floor

Are you standing on the floor?

No, I'm not standing on the floor; I'm sitting on the chair

Am I sitting on the chair?

No, you aren't sitting on the chair; you're standing on the floor

Is the mouse standing?

Yes, the mouse is standing

Is the dog standing?

No, the dog isn't standing; it's sitting

Is the cat standing behind the mouse?

No, the cat isn't standing behind the mouse; it's sitting behind the mouse

Am I taking the book from the table?

Yes, you're taking the book from the table

Am I putting the book on the table?

Yes, you're putting the book on the table

Am I putting the book on the floor?

No, you aren't putting the book on the floor; you're taking the book from the table

Am I taking the pen from the table?

No, you aren't taking the pen from the table; you're putting the book on the table

Am I closing the book?

Yes, you're closing the book

Am I opening the door?

Yes, you're opening the door

Am I opening the window?

No, you aren't opening the window; you're closing the door

Am I closing the window?

No, you aren't closing the window; you're opening the book
