Am I behind them?

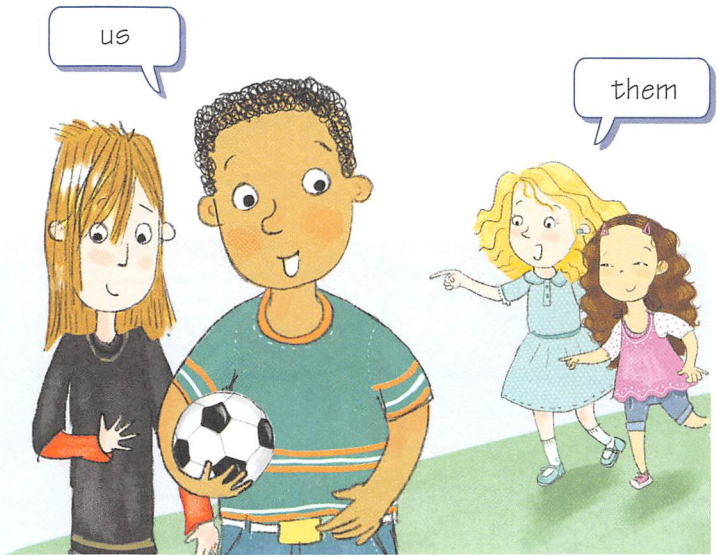
Yes, you're behind them

No, you aren't a pupil; you're the teacher

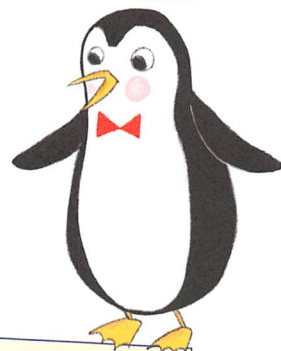
Is he the teacher?

What am I standing next to?

Who's Charlie Best standing next to?

Charlie Best's standing next to Mrs Best

Is the cat next to the dog?

No, the cat isn't next to the dog;
it's in front of the dog

Who are you looking at?

What am I looking at?

You're looking at the table (or the ceiling etc.)

Look at the door, please.

What's she doing?

She's looking at the door

Look at the pupil next to you, please.

What are you doing?

I'm looking at the pupil next to me

In this picture, who's Kate Best looking at?

In that picture, Kate Best's looking at the tall man

And where's Charlie Best looking: at Mrs Best
or at the giraffe?

Charlie Best's looking at Mrs Best
