What colour are their shoes?

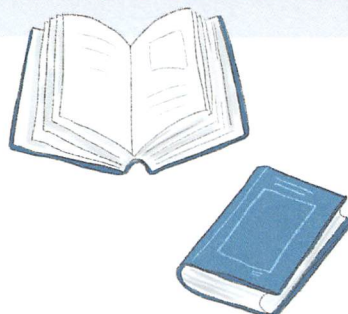
Their shoes are black etc.

*That part of the body is a foot*

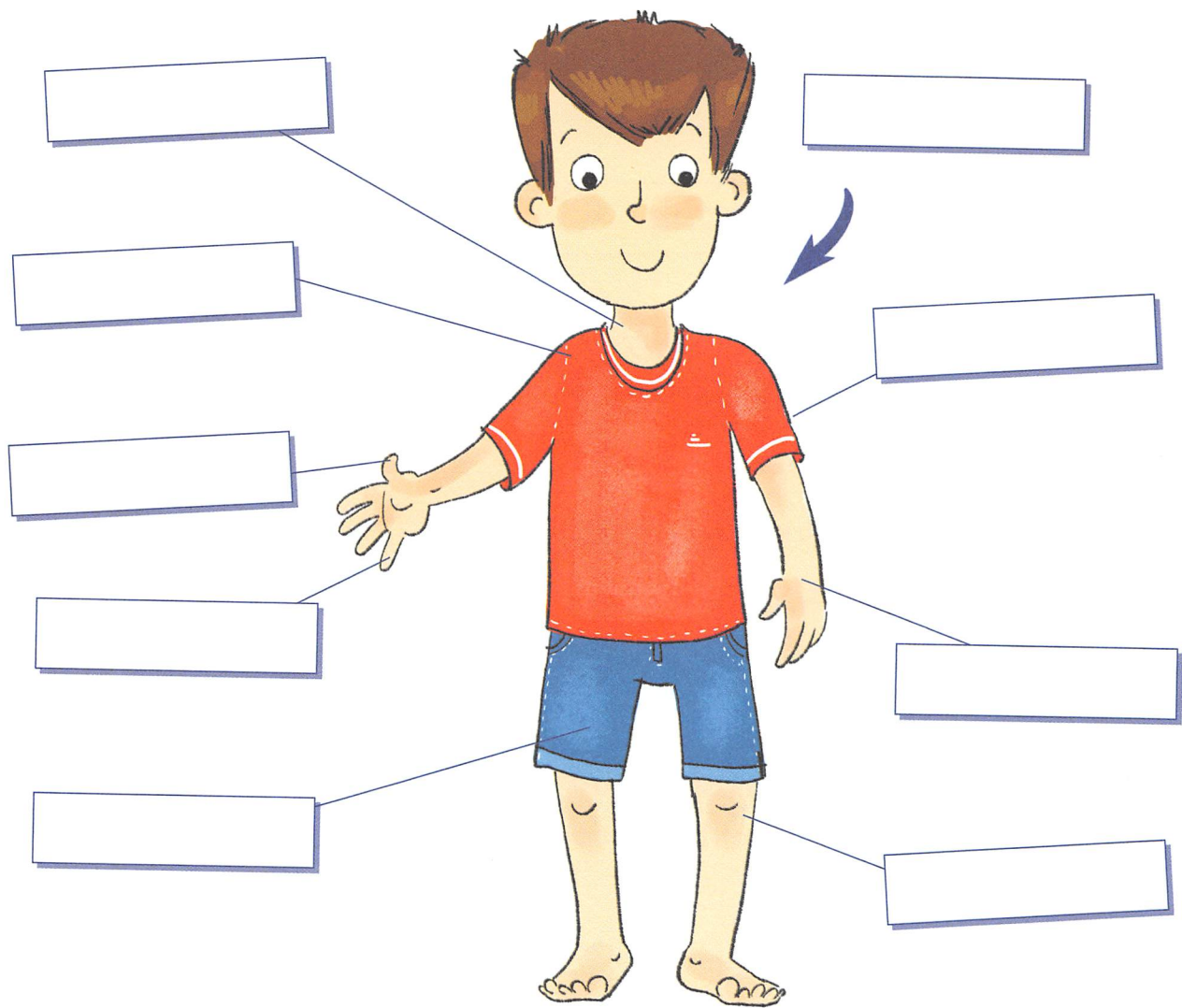
What's the plural of "foot"?
