Kangaroos move around by jumping

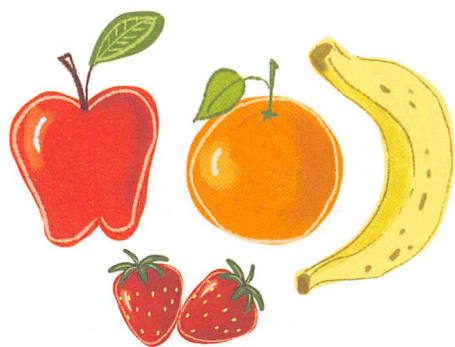

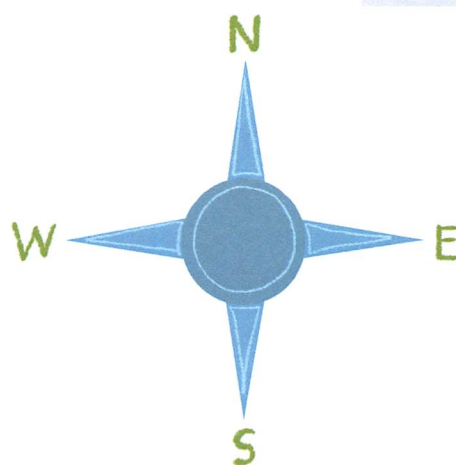
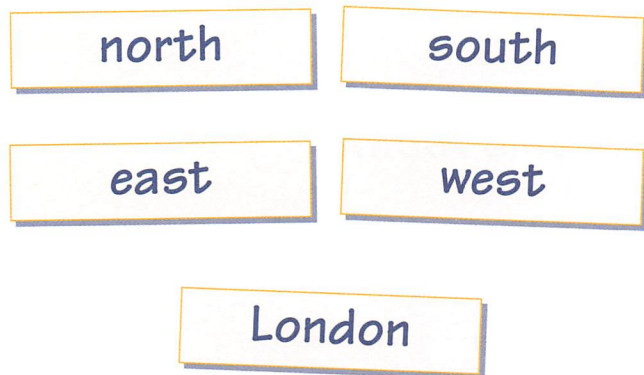


Tell me the names of four kinds of fruit, please.
