Do flats have stairs?

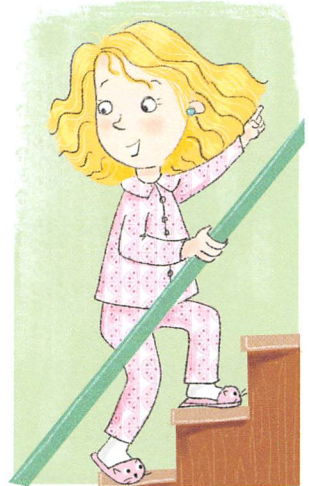
No, flats don't have stairs

No, I haven't got any sisters

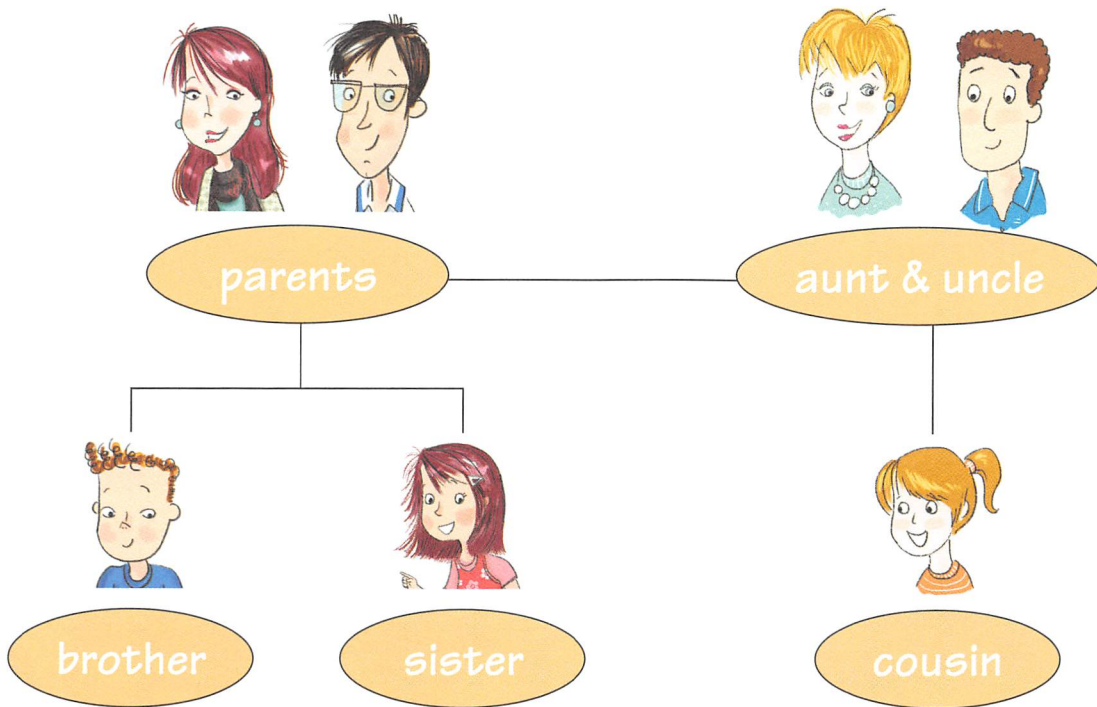
Are you an only child?

What's the difference between parents and relatives?

The difference between parents and relatives is that your parents are your mum and your dad, and your relatives are all the other people in your family, for example uncles, aunts, cousins etc.

What does the word "uncle" mean?

What does the word "aunt" mean?

The word "aunt" means your mum's sister, or your dad's sister

Another word for "relatives" is "relations"

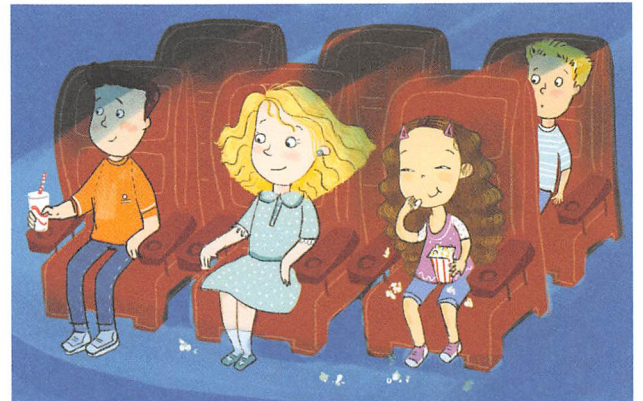

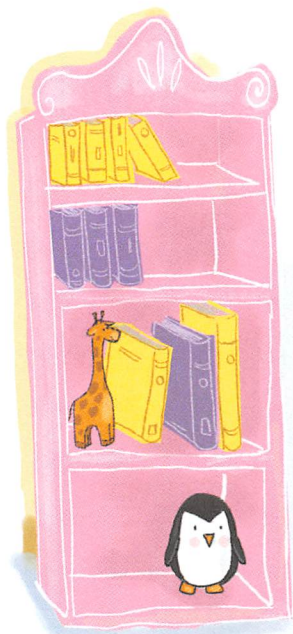
