What's an island?

What am I doing?

You're sneezing

When do people sneeze a lot?

People sneeze a lot when they catch a cold

When people catch a cold, do they feel well?

No, when people catch a cold, they don't feel well; they feel ill

What do we carry in our pocket when we have a cold?

We carry tissues or a handkerchief in our pocket when we have a cold

What am I doing?

You're coughing

Must we always cover our mouths when we cough or sneeze?

Yes, we must always cover our mouths when we cough or sneeze

The word "too" can mean "also".
We put "too" at the end of a sentence.
I can fly and I can hop too!



What's another word for "also"?

Another word for "also" is "too"

Make a sentence with the word "too", please.

My sister's good at science and she's good at art too

Me too!

I can sing well!

Me too!



Now, I'll say something, and you say "Me too!", "I don't" etc.

I love music

Me too! ~ I don't

I can touch the top of the door

Me too! ~ I can't

I've got a pet rabbit

Me too! ~ I haven't

I can sing very well

Me too! ~ I can't

I'm wearing a green shirt

Me too! ~ I'm not

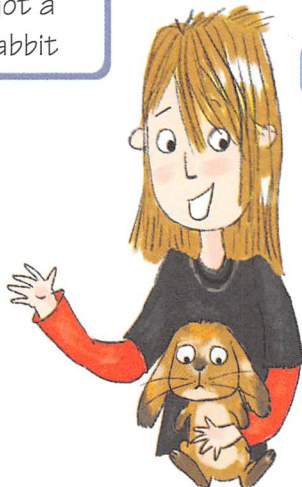
I'll wash my hair tomorrow

Preposition + “-ing”

good at running

instead of going

Prepositions are words like “at”, “of”, “with” and “by”. After a preposition, if we want to say an action, we use an “-ing” word.

You're good at speaking English now!



Is it right to say “Ducks are good at swim”?

No, it isn't right to say “Ducks are good at swim”

What must we say instead?

We must say “Ducks are good at swimming”

How do we start a car engine?

We start a car engine by turning a key

Finish this sentence, please: “We use shampoo for ...”

We use shampoo for washing our hair

Which is the best shop in this town for buying toys (or computer games, children's clothes etc.)?

Which is safer: swimming in the sea or swimming in a lake?

Swimming in a lake is safer than swimming in the sea

Why?

Because the waves on a lake aren't as high as the waves in the sea

How can we go from one side of a lake to the other without crossing the water?

We can go from one side of a lake to the other without crossing the water by walking round it

Tell me about the lake in this picture, please.

In that picture, some people are swimming in the lake, some people are fishing on the lake, and some people are sailing boats on the lake

bring

take

"bring" = "carry here"

"take" = "carry there"



What's the difference between "bring" and "take"?

The difference between "bring" and "take" is that "bring" means "carry here" and "take" means "carry there"

Bring your book to me, please.

What are you doing?

I'm bringing my book to you

Take your book to him, please.

What are you doing?

I'm taking my book to him

Give me a sentence with "bring" in it, please.

My mum brings me here for my lesson

Give me a sentence with "take" in it, please.

I take my bag home after the lesson

What am I doing?

You're taking your book into the corridor

What am I doing?

You're bringing your book into the classroom

What do you bring with you when you come to school?

I bring my ... with me when I come to school

Do you take that picture home with you after the lesson?

No, I don't take that picture home with me after the lesson

Why not?

Because it isn't mine

Do most people take cameras with them when they go on holiday?

Yes, most people take cameras with them when they go on holiday
