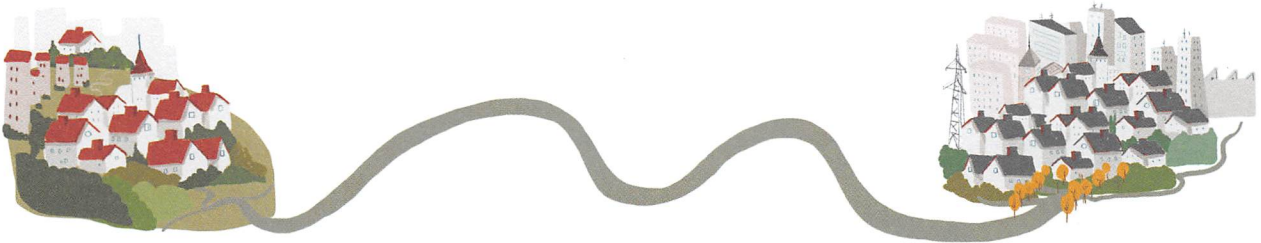

If we want to draw a very straight line on a piece of paper, we need a ruler

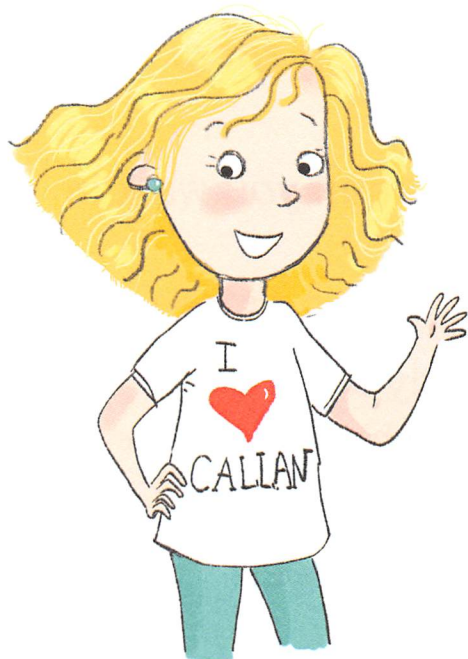
Of these four children, who's got wavy hair?

Adverb

quickly

slowly

nicely

A cat is a quick animal. A cat runs quickly.
A snail is a slow animal. A snail moves slowly.
Kate has a nice voice. Kate sings nicely.

Adverbs tell us about actions.
“I can say the alphabet quickly!”

The words “quick”, “slow” and “nice” are adjectives. They tell us about the cat, the snail, and Kate’s voice.

The words “quickly”, “slowly” and “nicely” are adverbs. Adverbs tell us about actions. They tell us how the cat runs, how the snail moves, and how Kate sings.



Are snails quick?

No, snails aren't quick; they're slow

Can snails move quickly?

No, snails can't move quickly; they move slowly

Make a sentence with the word “bad”, please.

Her son's homework is always bad

Make a sentence with the word “badly”, please.

Her son always does his homework badly

If you turn around quickly five times, can you walk in a straight line?

No, if I turn around quickly five times, I can't walk in a straight line

Can birds move their wings as quickly as bees?

No, birds can't move their wings as quickly as bees; they move their wings more slowly than bees

So if you arrive at the school at (a quarter to ten), how long must you wait?

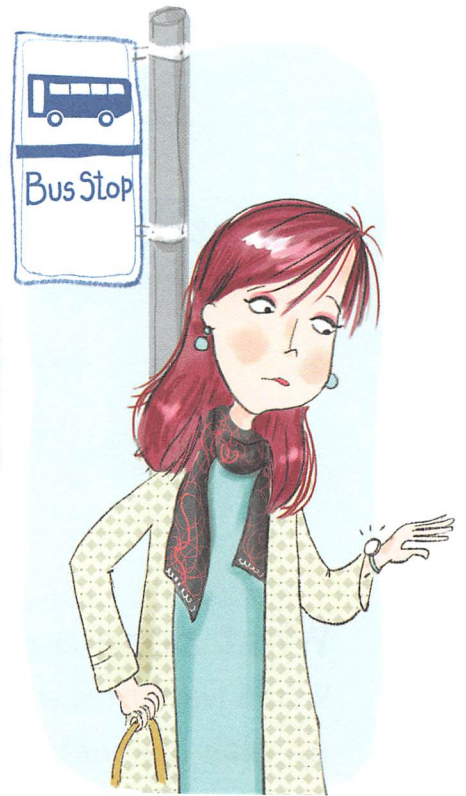
If I arrive at the school at (a quarter to ten), I must wait 15 minutes
