Is it healthy to eat lots of sugar and salt every day?

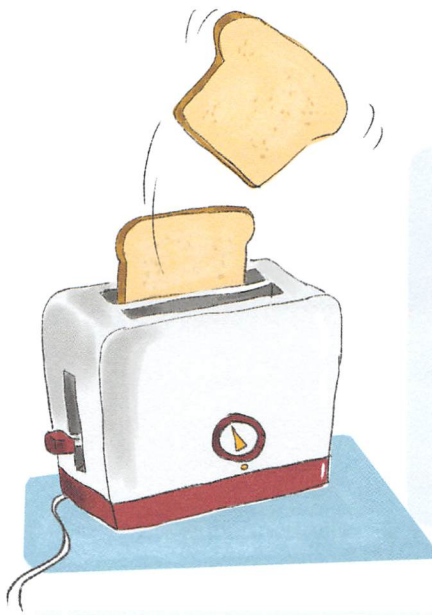
No, it isn't healthy to eat lots of sugar and salt every day; it's unhealthy

No, I don't agree that frogs have ugly faces; I disagree

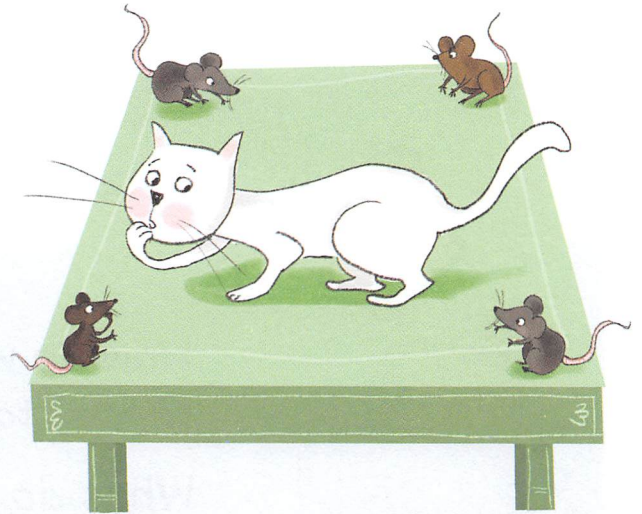
Do you always agree with everything your parents say?

Because a round table has no corners

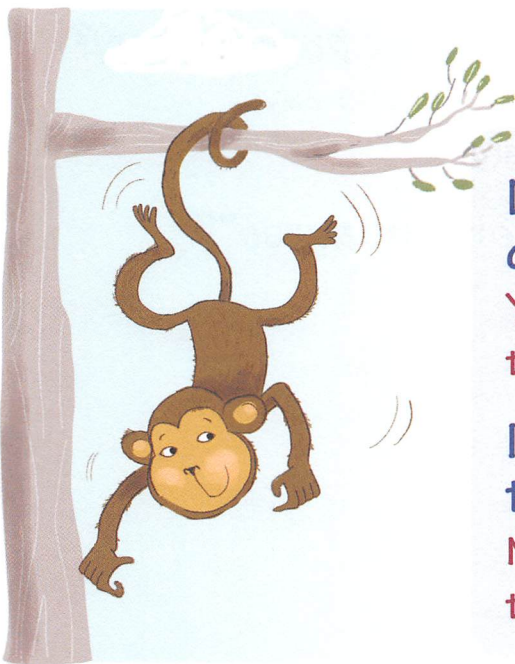
Where am I standing?

Is there a magazine that you like a lot?

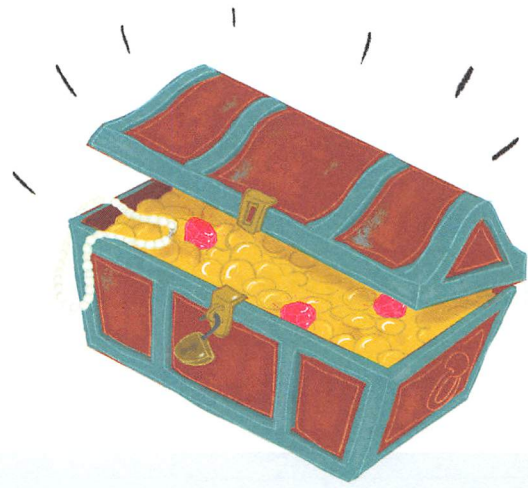
