## Past tenses of irregular verbs (3)

Here are some more irregular verbs!

sell	–	sold	begin	–	began
find	–	found	learn	–	learnt
shake	–	shook	dream	–	dreamt
forget	–	forgot	shine	–	shone
hear	–	heard	send	–	sent
feel	–	felt	fall	–	fell
smell	–	smelt	bring	–	brought
wake up	–	woke up	leave	–	left
sing	–	sang	understand	–	understood



What's the past tense of the verb "sell"?

The past tense of the verb "sell" is "sold"

Finish these sentences, please:

Last month, my parents sold ...

Last month, my parents sold their old car

Two weeks ago, I found ...

Two weeks ago, I found some money on the pavement

When my dad met my teacher yesterday, he shook ...

When my dad met my teacher yesterday, he shook hands with him

This morning, I forgot ...

This morning, I forgot to brush my hair

Did you hear me say “Good morning” (or afternoon etc.) at the beginning of the lesson?

Yes, I heard you say “Good morning” at the beginning of the lesson

Did you feel tired when you went to bed last night?

Yes, I felt tired when I went to bed last night

Did your lunch smell horrible yesterday?

No, my lunch didn't smell horrible yesterday; it smelt good

What was the first thing you saw when you woke up this morning?

The first thing I saw when I woke up this morning was the ceiling (the door etc.)

Did Charlie and Dan sing “Happy Birthday to You” at the party yesterday?

Yes, Charlie and Dan sang “Happy Birthday to You” at the party yesterday

When did you begin studying English?

I began studying English ... months (or years) ago

And what was the first English word you learnt?

“Hello” was the first English word I learnt

What did you dream last night?

I dreamt ... last night

Did the sun shine last summer?

Yes, the sun shone last summer

Did anybody send you an email last week?

Yes, somebody sent me an email last week ~ No, nobody sent me an email last week

Did you often fall over when you were a little baby?

Yes, I often fell over when I was a little baby

What did I bring with me to the lesson today?

You brought your book with you to the lesson today

Who was with you when you left home this morning (or afternoon)?

... was with me when I left home this morning

Did you understand the last question I asked?

Yes, I understood the last question you asked

What message do we generally write inside a Christmas card?

We generally write the message "Merry Christmas" inside a Christmas card

Are people merry when they're on a holiday?

Yes, people are merry when they're on holiday

What's ... like?

What's your house (or flat) like?

My house is old, it's got three bedrooms and a big garden etc.

What was the weather like yesterday?

Yesterday, it was hot and sunny all morning, but it rained a little in the afternoon etc.

I've got ...

Do people often fall over when they're learning to skate?

Yes, people often fall over when they're learning to skate

Which do you think is faster: a pair of roller skates or a skateboard?

I think ... is faster than ...

Do you speak English quite well?

Yes, I speak English quite well

Do you go to visit your grandparents quite often?

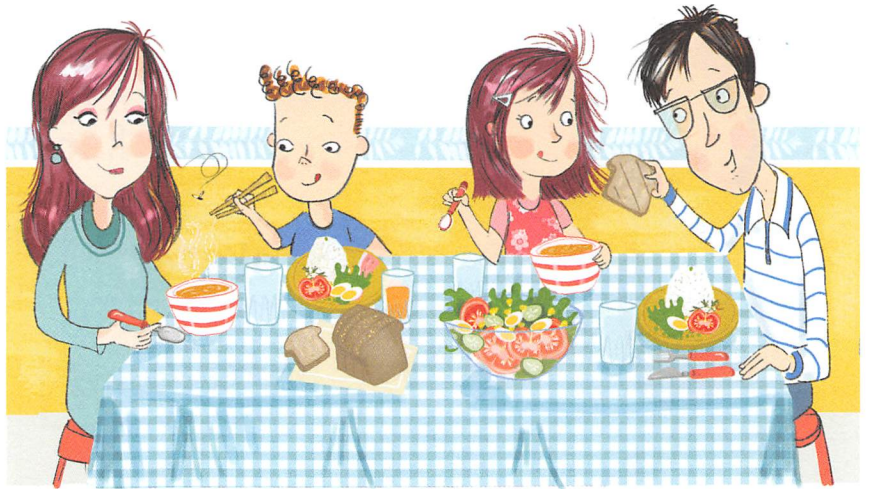
Yes, I go to visit my grandparents quite often ~
