Is there a bear anywhere in this building?

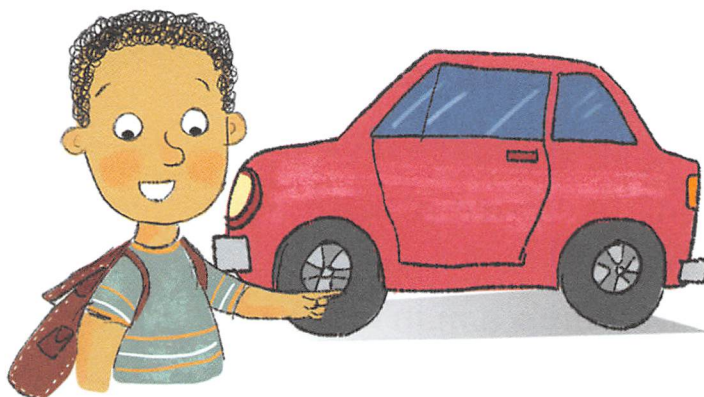
No, there isn't a bear anywhere in this building

Sometimes, we can use "that" instead of "which" and "who":

Mr Best bought a car **that** cost lots of money.I have a dog **that** can run very quickly.Max is a boy **that** laughs all the time.

Are you wearing anything which is made of gold?

Yes, I'm wearing something which is made of gold ~ No, I'm not wearing anything which is made of gold

Name me some animals which have long tails, please.

Kangaroos and giraffes are animals which have long tails

In your family, is there a man who has a long beard?

Yes, in my family, there's a man who has a long beard ~ No, in my family, there isn't a man who has a long beard





What's a farmer?

A farmer is a person who lives and works on a farm

Is a pet an animal that lives with us at home?

Yes, a pet is an animal that lives with us at home

What's a nurse?

A nurse is a person that looks after us in a hospital

OK, now I'll say two sentences, and you must say one sentence with "which", "who" or "that":

**Uncle Charles has a moustache.
His moustache is long and curly.**

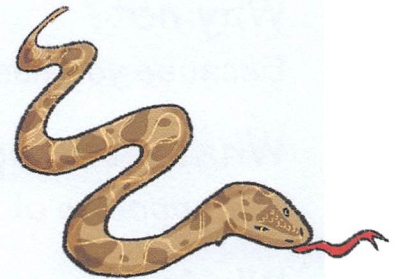
Uncle Charles has a moustache which (or that) is long and curly

**Nobody saw the snake.
The snake quietly entered the room.**

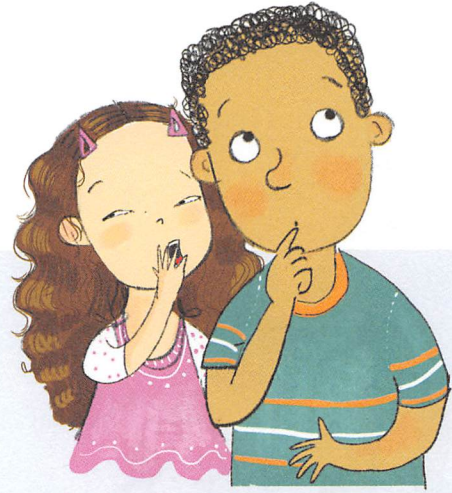
Nobody saw the snake which (or that) quietly entered the room

**Yesterday, I met a woman.
The woman had purple hair.**

decide

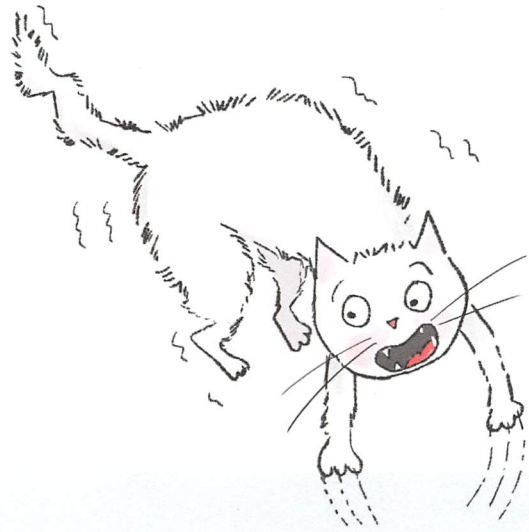
Who decides what you eat for breakfast every day: you or your parents?
