Autumn follows summer

Which number follows the number thirteen?

Fourteen follows the number thirteen

Which are generally deeper: rivers or lakes?

Lakes are generally deeper than rivers

Do you think there are monsters deep under the sea?

Yes, I think there are monsters deep under the sea ~ No, I don't think there are monsters deep under the sea

What's the opposite of deep?

The opposite of deep is shallow

Why do some people always stay in the shallow end of a swimming pool?

Some people always stay in the shallow end of a swimming pool because they can't swim (or can't swim well)

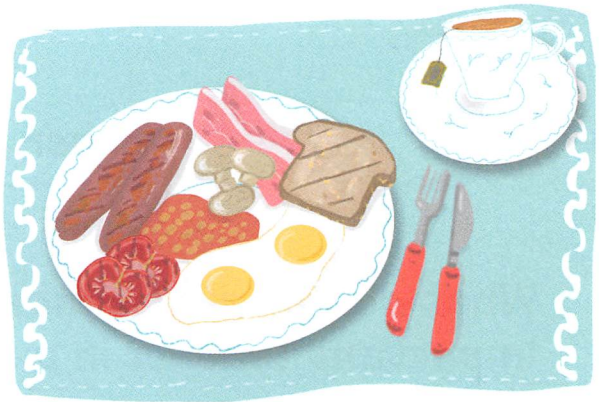
English breakfast

Yes, I'm going to do something exciting next weekend ~ No, I'm not going to do anything exciting next weekend

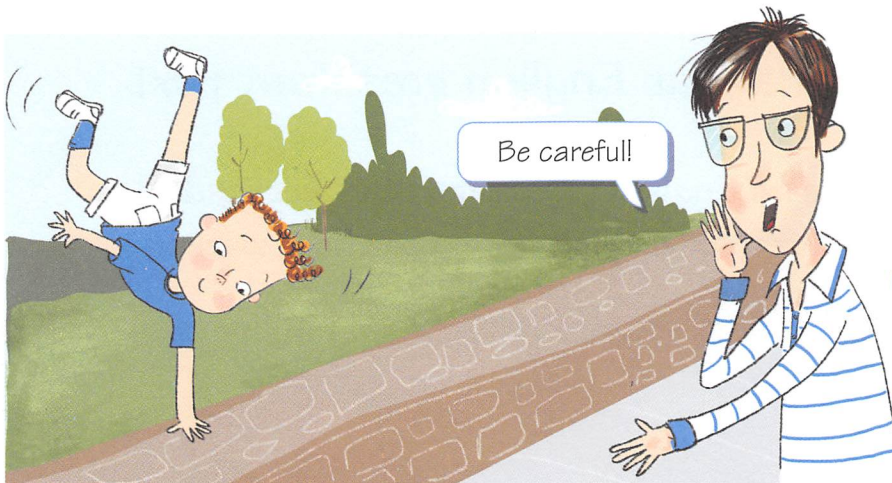
head teacher
