- is a formal letter that we send a long with our CV when we apply for a job;
- is written for three main reasons; to say which job we're applying for, to persuade the reader that our CV is worth reading, and to let them know our availability for interview;
- should start (if we know the name of the person dealing with applications) with "Dear Mr Jones", not "Dear David" or "Dear David Jones"; and at the end, we should write "Yours sinterely". If we don't know the name of the person dealing with applications, we should start with "Dear Sir or Madam"; at the end, we should write "Yours faithfully".
