### Hint 英語の文書に慣れるコツ

TOEIC Bridgeのリーディングでは、とくに長い文章を読むことはありません。また格別難しい語句が用いられているわけでもありません。しかし、日常生活で使われている語彙を増やしておくことは大切です。

たとえば、カタカナ語として定着している語について、英語本来の意味を確認しておくといいいでしょう。たとえばstoveという単語——わたしたちは「ストーブ」という暖房器具を思い起しますが、英語のstoveが意味するのは「料理用のレンジ」であることが多いのです。またstoryというつづり字の語には「ストーリー（物語）」の意味の単語のほかに「階」の意味の単語もあり、the second story（2階）やthree-story house（3階建て家屋）のように使われます。こういった点にも注意を払いながら語彙力をつけるように心掛けておくとよいでしょう。

英語の色々な書式に慣れておくことも大切です。手紙や電子メールで多用される語句や、図表でよく見かける各種の省略表記・記号などの意味を頭に入れておくと、これらの書式の理解が容易になります。

- Attn. Attention to ...の省略形で「…あて」の意味  
Re: regardingの省略形で「…の件」の意味  
ASAP as soon as possibleの省略で「なるべく早く；至急」の意味  
R.S.V.P. フランス語のRépondez s'il vous plaîtの省略で「ご返答を請う」の意味  
thru throughの発音表記で、期間や経由地を表す  
w/ withの略号  
w/o withoutの略号
