Grammar Point:

“Their” refers to the sentence subject “Mercury” which is singular, therefore, “its” should be used instead of “their”

Key Vocabulary:

Proximity (noun - singular): Near to

Ambient (adjective): The surrounding area

Surface (noun-singular): Top of something

Temperature (noun-singular): How hot or cold it is

Mercury (noun-singular): The planet nearest the sun

Range (verb): Extend or vary

Kelvin (noun-singular): A unit of temperature

TOEFL® Tip:

Pronouns, such as he, she or it can often replace the noun of a sentence. When you see a pronoun in a TOEFL® sentence, make sure to match it with its noun. Also, be sure of the role it has in the sentence, whether subject, object, or possessive.

English Tip:

Subject pronouns: I, you, he, she, it, we, you, they.

Object pronouns: Me, you, him, her, it, us, you, them.

Possessive pronouns: Mine, yours, his, hers, its, ours, theirs.

Key Vocabulary:

Renown (noun - singular): Very famous

Hot-springs (noun-plural): Natural hot water baths, usually over 37 degrees

Sand-baths (noun-plural): Natural hot sand, usually over 37 degrees

TOEFL® Tip:

The first thing you probably want to do with TOEFL® grammar questions is to find both the subject and verb of each sentence and check if they are singular or plural. Basically, if the subject is plural the verb has to be plural, and vice versa.

English Tip:

The following subjects are SINGULAR even though they seem plural: anybody, anyone, anything, everybody, everyone, everything, nobody, no one, nothing, somebody, someone, each + noun, every + noun.

English Tip:

In general, adjectives are words used to help describe the nouns, whereas adverbs are used to describe verbs

Ex:

Adjective: She is beautiful.

Adverb: She sings beautifully.
