singular plural

You add -es to most nouns in -o:

Is that a potato? I had some potatoes for lunch.

(But just add -s to photo, radio and piano)

Nouns ending in consonant + y change to consonant + ies:

Which country are you from? We visited ten countries.

This is a photo of me as a baby. I can hear babies crying.

(But for vowel + y, just add -s: day - days/boy - boys)
