⁴Then one day the **unsuspecting** woman came into the supermarket. ⁵As she picked up a package of cheese, she felt a **sharp** pain in her right hand. ⁶She looked down, **horrified** to see a **nasty** rat. "It was as big as my hand and hanging on my finger," the woman told a local newspaper. The rat was trying to steal her cheese. ⁷She bravely pulled the rat off with her left hand and started banging it on the floor. ⁸"The animal was on the floor, knocked completely **unconscious**," said the proud woman later.


