Frequently Asked Questions

Q1. Why do I need to take the TOEFL@ITP?

As mentioned earlier, the TOEFL® ITP is only available at certain institutions. Usually students take the TOEFL® ITP for entrance tests, student exchange programs, internships, traveling abroad, or for admission into certain programs. However, you need to check with your university or institution to make sure you are taking the correct TOEFL® test.

Q2. How long does it take to receive my TOEFL® ITP score?

It usually takes 1-3 weeks for the university or institution to provide you with your score. However, you should check with your university or institution, as this may vary.

Q3. Can I use my TOEFL® score for graduate level or undergraduate programs at other institutions other than the one I took the test at?

No, unless the university or institution you took the test at has a special agreement with the university in which you are trying to use it at.

Q4. How long will my test scores be valid for?

Your test scores should be valid for 2 years from the date you took the test.

Q5. How many times am I allowed to take the TOEFL® ITP test?

Usually you can take the TOEFL® ITP test 3 times per a semester, unless differently instructed by your university or institution.

Q6. Is TOEFL® ITP difficult?

Yes and no. It depends on how prepared you are.

Q7. How much time should I spend preparing for the TOEFL® ITP?

This book has been designed to be used before taking the test. This textbook will take about 10 hours to complete, but we highly recommend taking at least 15 hours to carefully read every single word.
