Test tip

Decide what the blank is referring to Often the sentence in the test will feature both a subject and one or more objects. Decide whether the blank is replacing a subject or an object and choose the correct pronoun.

Test tip

Often the answer choices will have both possessive pronouns (e.g. my) and adjectives (e.g. mine). Look at the sentence to decide whether the blank is modifying a noun (possessive adjective) or replacing it (possessive pronoun).

Grammar note

Possessive adjectives are generally found next to the noun. Sometimes, though, there may be another adjective before the noun.
