Chan: Well, how about leaving the office at 6:00?

Nakamura: OK. Tomorrow at 6:00, then.

■ Ms. Nakamura and Ms. Chan are going to the Sakura Art Museum tomorrow after work. They will leave the office at 6:00. It takes about forty minutes to get from the company to the Sakura Art Museum.

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NOTES

1. Nan-ji ni kaisha o demashō ka.

The particle **o** here indicates a point of departure.

ex. **6-ji ni kaisha o demasu.** "I'll leave the office at 6:00."

Shinjuku Eki de densha o orimasu. "I'll get off the train at Shinjuku Station."

The particle **ni**, on the other hand, indicates a point of arrival or a location toward which an action such as going, coming, entering, or boarding is directed.

ex. **7-ji ni bijutsukan ni tsukimasu.** "I'll arrive at the art museum at 7:00."






