'I expect you to be here at 9 o'clock,' his mother said.

The officer ordered the soldiers to go back.

They told us to be at the train station at 6 o'clock.

3 You can use verb + wh-word + to + infinitive with some verbs:

ask explain learn understand decide forget know remember

I can't explain how to do it, I'm sorry. We can't decide what to eat. I didn't know what to do. I can never remember how to spell that word.


