You are kind.

You are so kind. (= very kind)

Jim's tall.

He's such a tall person!

Teel so good today. The weather's so nice. He's so young.

so + adverb:
Everything happened so

so many so much so few so little:

There are so many wonderful shops here! We had so little time.

I know so few people. There's so much to do!

The patterns with such are different:

- a such + a/an (+ adjective) + singular noun: Henry is such a sweet person. The dog made such a mess!
- b such (+ adjective) + uncountable noun: I've never had such good advice. This is such boring homework.
- c such (+ adjective) + plural noun: He paints such beautiful pictures.
