Do you know where . . . ? I don't know what . . . , etc.

Do you know where Paula is?





We say:

Where is Paula?

Do you know where Paula is ? but (not Do you know where is Paula?)

In the same way we say:

I know I don't know

where Paula is.

Can you tell me where Paula is?

Compare:

Who are those people? How old is Nicole? What time is it? Where can I go? How much is this camera? When are you leaving town? Where have they gone? What was Jenny wearing?

but

Do you know Can you tell me

I know I don't know I don't remember who those people are how old Nicole is what time it is where I can go

how much this camera is when you're leaving town where they have gone what Jenny was wearing
